This woman was so ill she had mosquito bites all over her because she had to sit up outside all night just to breathe. When we went to pray for her, she had an awful stench about her. Our field director is a doctor and saw this woman at a clinic where he works. She has a lung infection and is being tested for TB. The same week we had an outreach in our home and she is the only one who came forward to receive Christ. (We had about 50 people there). She is now coming to one of our three Bible studies we have in Khmer homes. She looks like a new person and is continually praising Jesus now. Her sister who has been coming to the study asked for a Bible to take home after seeing her sister's faith and God's healing.



Although we do not have Bible studies in our home anymore, we still have outreaches now and then for adults and children. **Please pray for our vision to start a church in our neighborhood.**



The teen girl in the back is the youngest of the seven teen girls (age 14) we are discipling in the neighborhood. On her own, she has started a Bible class for children in her home which is a tiny shack. These are her students who come 3 times a week for an hour. We supply her with coloring materials, stickers, Bible story books, etc. (The Khmer wear pajamas outside their homes... they don't think of them as pajamas, though... more like play clothes. Adults wear them too.)

Please pray for us. Our field leadership has approached us for help and we need to make some decisions which we will tell you more about next month. For now, we need your prayers for God to give us wisdom.

We are very excited because from June 13th through June 22nd, two things will happen. We will have our annual field conference and our home church, Davisville, is sending a group to help us teach and watch the children during the conference. We are so thankful for those of you who have given to help them come. We are amazed at how encouraged we feel already and they



haven't even come yet! Thank you for caring for us and the Khmer people.
